

UPSC NDA Performance Statistics

Sainik School Purulia | NDA exam cycles from April 2022 to September 2025

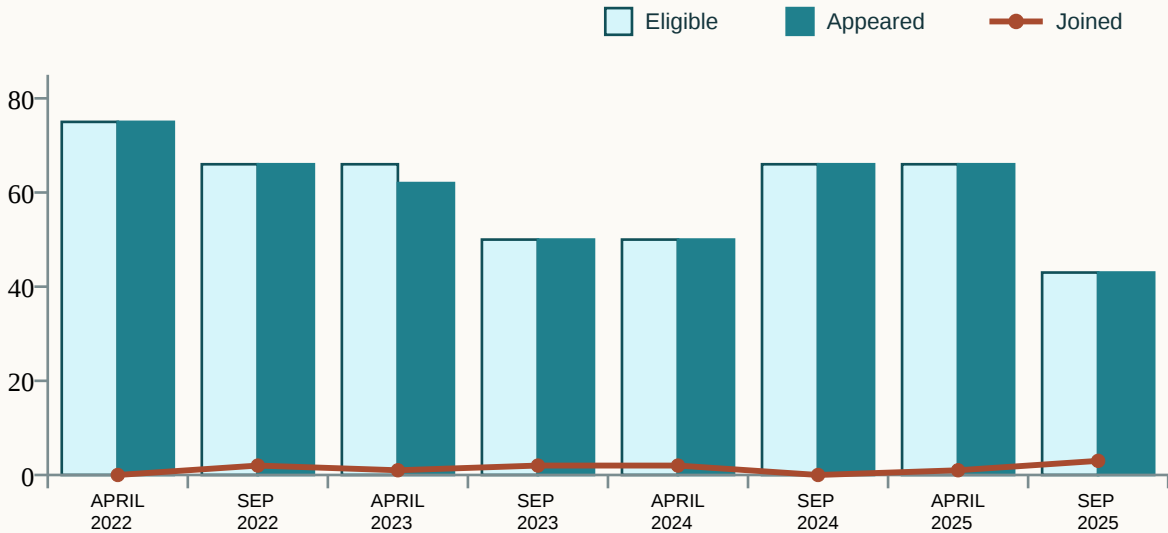
This report consolidates eight NDA exam cycles into a single performance view, covering participation, written qualification, SSB progression, and final NDA joining outcomes.

Key findings

- Across all eight cycles, 482 students were eligible, 478 appeared for the written examination, and 11 finally joined NDA.
- The aggregate appearance rate was 99.2%, while the overall written qualification rate was 18.8% of appeared candidates.
- The strongest written result came in SEP 2023 with a 40.0% written qualification rate.
- The best final joining efficiency came in SEP 2025 with a 7.0% joining rate, and the highest absolute number of final joins was 3 in SEP 2025.

Eligible candidates, appeared candidates, and final NDA joins

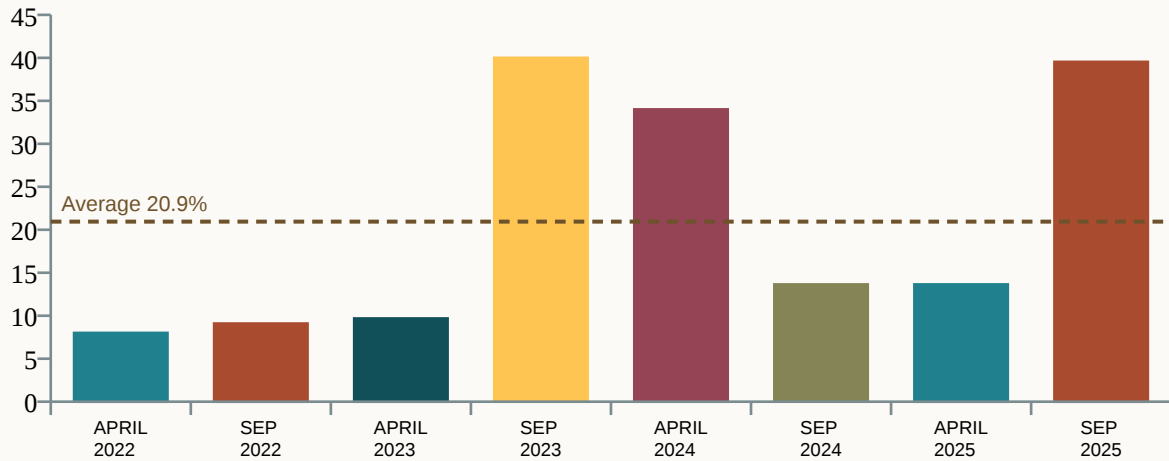


Participation remained consistently high across the period. In most cycles, almost every eligible cadet appeared for the written exam, so the real performance separation came later in the funnel.

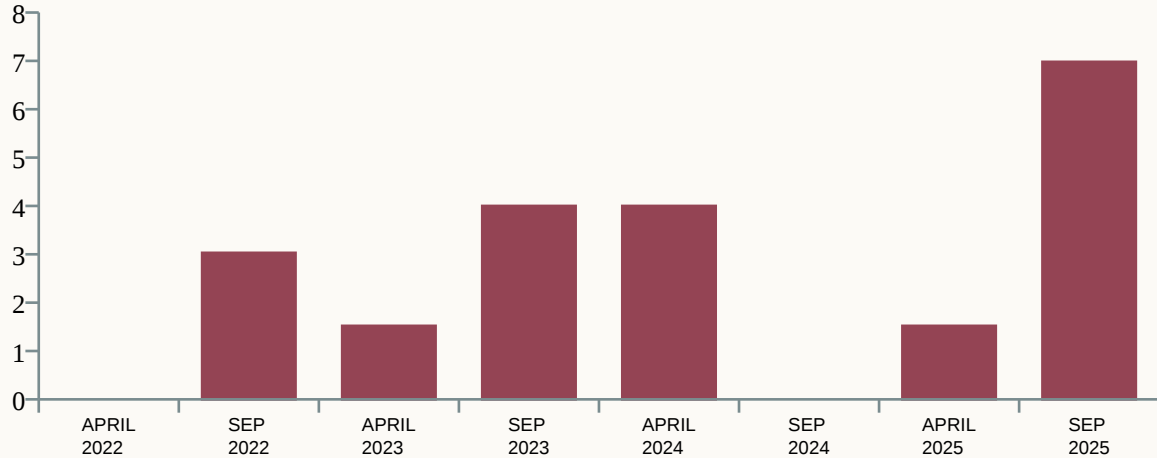
Conversion efficiency

The next two charts focus on how efficiently each batch converted appearances into written qualifications and then into actual NDA joining. This is the most useful lens for comparing cycles of different sizes.

Final NDA joining rate by exam cycle



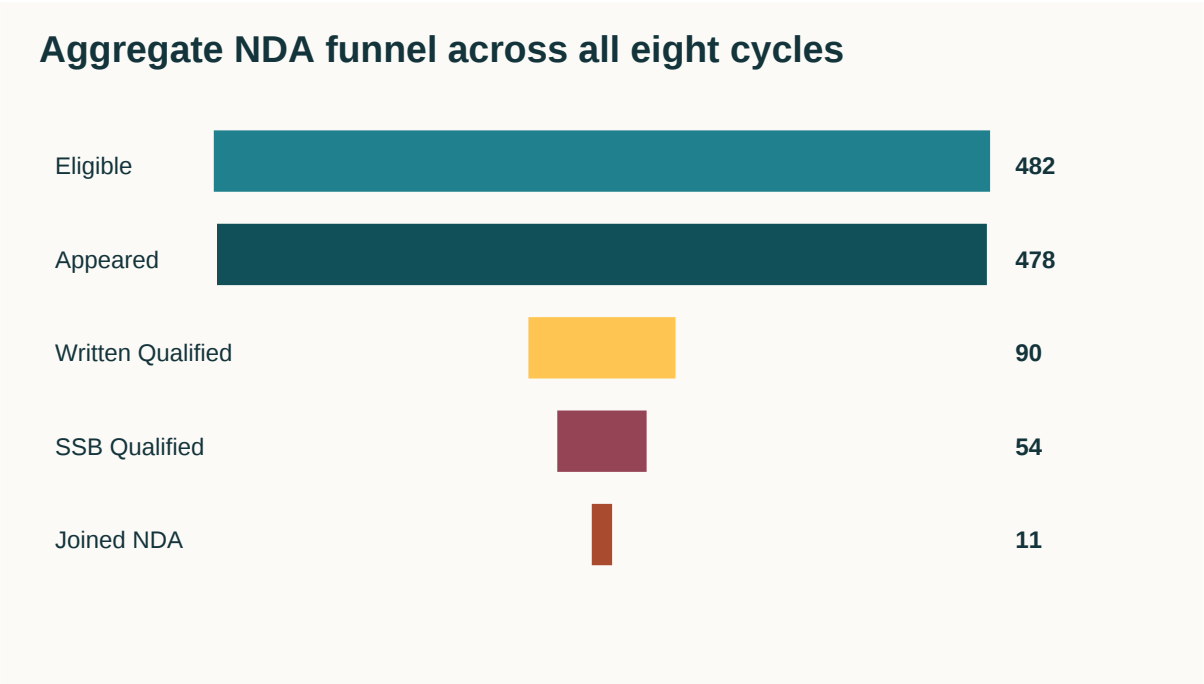
Overall, 60.0% of written-qualified candidates went on to become SSB qualified, and the final joining rate across the full eligible pool was 2.3%.

Aggregate funnel and interpretation

Viewed as a funnel, the main attrition point was the written examination stage. Once students cleared written and SSB stages in strong numbers, the final NDA joining count still depended on medical fitness and final merit position, which capped conversion in several cycles.
